PRODUCER MEMBERS STALLS

Over 20 stalls in our **Saturday** producer members market offers Dublin's best selection of baked goods, cheeses, organic fruit and vegetables, and much more. Cold and hot food and drinks are available to enjoy in our relaxed café area.

On **Thursdays and Fridays**, the open stalls are fruits and vegetables, Lino Olivieri's and the Thursday café.

SUNDAY MARKETS

Independent markets, which take place on the Co-op premises. The core area is also open and vegs and fruits available.

Dublin Food Co-op is also a community space that hosts a range of events and activities – from cookery classes to martial arts, film screenings to local GIY meetings.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership is at the very heart of the Co-op and the key to our uniqueness. We are owned and controlled by our members; participation and volunteering are our lifeblood and the reason we thrive.



In the tradition of co-operatives, we deliver significant benefits to our members, including the chance to:

- obtain 5% discount on all purchases of Co-op core goods
- receive additional discounts for volunteering on the Help Rota or in a Working group (ask for information – see Volunteering leaflet)
- make bulk and special orders on Co-op core goods at discounted rates
- receive members' news information and services, including training and meet-up groups
- elect the members of the Coordinating Body (Board of Directors) or even stand yourself
- put forward ideas, projects and activities and participate in decision-making and the running of the Co-op

Fáilte sessions are held on the **first Saturday** of every month at 14pm to welcome and introduce new members to the Co-op.

JOIN US

New members buy an individual **€1 share** to gain joint ownership of the Co-op and pay an annual membership fee.

WHICH MEMBERSHIP FOR YOU?

Single membership: one member, one share, one vote.

Joint membership: two members, one share, one vote, and two cards.

Household membership: two shares, two votes, and up to four cards.

All memberships entitle the members to 5% discount and enable them to volunteer for an extra 10%.

For administrative reasons, the cards can be printed **ONLY IN THE NAME OF THE SHAREHOLDERS**. The other members of the household if any, or the joint member, will get a copy of these cards for personal use.

VOLUNTEERING

Volunteers members contribute approximately 2h every five weeks in one of the HelpRotas and receive an additional 10% discount in the dry goods area.
